

General Guidelines

- ✚ For the safety of the campers, no one will be allowed to attend a camp that is outside their age group.
- ✚ Vehicles are to remain parked in the designated areas throughout camp.
- ✚ All campers are expected to attend the entire camp.
- ✚ No camper will be allowed to come and go from camp without the permission of the Camp Leader/Director.
- ✚ All campers 18 years or older are expected to abide by the same rules as the other campers.
- ✚ No one under 18 is allowed to leave the camp without the permission of their parents.
- ✚ Failure to agree AND to abide with the rules and guidelines of this camp may result in the dismissal or refusal of a camper or staff to come to camp. A camper or staff member may be refused admission to camp at any time at the discretion of the Camp Directors, Camp Coordinator, Camp

Rules & Policies

Every organized event must have rules. These rules are for your own safety and the safety of others. They have been designed to make your camping experience enjoyable while making sure your actions don't interfere with the enjoyment of others. This is the Biblical Principle of Law and we ask and expect your compliance. Attendance at this Camp is subject to your understanding and compliance of these rules. You may be sent home for violation of these rules at the discretion of the Camp Directors, the Camp Coordinator, or the Camp/Retreat Administrator.

- ✚ Campers are required to attend all classes and services.
- ✚ No one may leave the camp at any time without permission of the Camp Directors.
- ✚ Use equipment with care. Deliberate loss or damage must be paid for!
- ✚ No one is permitted out of his/her cabin after lights out.
- ✚ We maintain Christian morals and principles. No profanity will be tolerated.
- ✚ Campers dress must be moderate. No shorts (2-in above knee), revealing clothing, etc. (see [dress code](#)).
- ✚ Girls' cabins are off limits to boys and boys' cabins are off limits to girls.
- ✚ No smoking, drinking, or drug use. This will not be tolerated.
- ✚ No apparel will be worn that is of an offensive nature, either by style, message, graphics, etc.
- ✚ Campers must stay in lighted and designated areas.
- ✚ NO THREATS and No fighting or aggressive behavior will be tolerated.
- ✚ No weapons of any kind will be allowed.
- ✚ No [cell phones](#), headphones, hand games, TVs, radios, iPods, etc. are allowed in camp.
- ✚ No malicious destruction of another's property.
- ✚ No stealing will be tolerated.
- ✚ No medications can be taken without the nurse's presence or permission.
- ✚ Camp Agape is not responsible for the theft, damage, or loss of your property.

Dress Code

- ✚ Campers may not wear halters, spaghetti straps, revealing or translucent clothing, or apparel that exposes the midriff. Garments are not allowed to "sag" to the point of allowing undergarments to be exposed.
- ✚ No clothing may be worn that displays pictures, trademarks, or advertising of tobacco products, beer or alcoholic beverages, controlled substances, or sexually suggestive pictures or words.
- ✚ No offensive clothing that promotes or implies violence will be tolerated. Because of recent schoolyard tragedies, this will be strictly enforced. The Camp Coordinator, Camp Directors and Deans will determine all decisions about the offensiveness of your clothing.
- ✚ Shorts are to be of a reasonable and moderate length (the fingertip rule will apply – 2-inches). Try to exercise good judgment. If the Camp Directors and/or Deans feel your shorts are not long enough, they will ask you to change.

Any questions about the appropriateness of your attire should be brought to the Camp Directors. Their decisions are final.

Since this is a Christian camp, we wish to maintain a high standard of conduct. We appreciate your cooperation in this manner. If you are asked to change, please don't be offended. We're here to help you and not hurt you.
